

M3 junction 9 to 14 motorway upgrade update and traffic bulletin
week commencing 20 September 2021

Work to improve journeys by upgrading the M3 motorway is planned to start later this year. We'll be installing narrow lanes in both directions between junction 9 at Winchester and junction 14 at Eastleigh, and the hard shoulder will be used as a running lane. This will provide a safe working area in the central reservation, whilst keeping three lanes open during the daytime.

To get the hard shoulder ready for this, preparation work continues under daytime hard shoulder closures, overnight lane closures with some planned carriageway and/or slip road closures. All traffic management for full overnight carriageway and/or slip road closures will usually be rolled out from 9pm and taken off by 6am.

Slip road closures planned for this week are as follows:

- **M3 junction 14 / M27 junction 4 – the M3 junction 14 southbound link road the M27 junction 4 westbound will be closed overnight on Wednesday 22, Thursday 23 and Friday 24 September 2021**
 - **Diversion:** Exit the M3 on to the M27 eastbound, continue to junction 5 turn and re-enter the M27 westbound.
- **M3 junction 13 – the M3 junction 13 southbound entry slip road will be closed overnight on Wednesday 22, Thursday 23 and Friday 24 September 2021**
 - **Diversion:** Join the M3 at junction 13 northbound, continue to junction 12, exit and turn around and re-join the M3 southbound.
- **M3 junction 9 – the M3 junction 9 southbound entry slip roads will be closed overnight on Wednesday 22, Thursday 23 and Friday 24 September 2021**
 - **Diversion:** Join the M3 at junction 9 northbound, continue to junction 8, turn around and re-join the M3 southbound.
- **M3 junction 9 – the M3 junction 9 northbound exit slip roads will be closed overnight on Monday 20 and Tuesday 21 September 2021**
 - **Diversion:** continue on the M3 to junction 8, turn around and re-join the M3 at junction 8 southbound and exit the M3 at junction 9.
