### 4. Assessment of Parish Accounts and Reserves 2021/22

The Lloyds Treasurer's Account stood at £28,538.18 with forecast end of year balance at £1,000+. The two Lloyds accounts held on 32 days' notice stood at £17,215.99 (former 6 month Investment Account) and £29,675.85 (former 12 month Investment Account). Reserves represented: Emergency Contingency £11,002.17; CIL Funds £6,213.82; Replacement of long term assets £29,675.85.

### 5. Assessment of Draft Budget 2022/23

The RFO had drawn up the Draft based on requirements and input from all Councillors. Items of Expenditure and Income were individually considered with detailed comments. Regular Expenditure total: £37,016 and Regular Income total: £2,734. Additional Expenditure total: £4,100 and Additional Income total: £0. Additional Expenditure comprised:

Open Spaces:  $2^{nd}$  year of up to 4 year programme for tree work and cutting back £1,000. Recreation Ground:  $2^{nd}$  year of up to 4 year programme for tree and cutting back £1,000. Sponder's Mede/Old Churchyard:  $2^{nd}$  year of up to 4 year programme for tree work £500. Recreation Ground: additional signage £1,000. Otterbourne in Bloom: £600. S137 Items:

Winchester Citizens Advice Bureau: £150; War Memorial wreath £25; Parish Magazine £120; SOCCT £500; Other set aside (recipients tbc) £300.

C/f items anticipated from 2021/22 Budget:

Platinum Jubilee (formerly 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of VE Day) £1,353. All other items would be assessed at financial year end.

# 6. Budget for 2022/23

Total Expenditure agreed £41,116. Total Income anticipated £2,734. Reserves reduced £0. Reserves to be added £1,709 for reimbursement of pavilion refurbishment (4th year). Budget proposed £40,091 as per the attached.

# 7. Recommendation of Precept for 2022/23

A Precept of  $\pounds40,091$  was unanimously agreed to recommend to full Council representing a 1.52% decrease on 2021/22 and  $\pounds56.43$  per household per annum at Band D using a Tax Base of 710.44.
